The Position

Job Requirements

- Minimum of a Master's degree from an accredited institution in fields of study related to the Social Sciences and/or Social Studies Education.
- Minimum of 5 years of teaching experience in grades 6-12 in the subjects to be taught
- Experience in curriculum development.
- Clear, consistent and respectful communicator with excellent written and verbal communication and listening skills, as well as a demonstrated ability to problem solve and collaborate.
- Efficient time management and the ability to take on many tasks at once and prioritize them by importance and relevance.
- Good at problem-solving quickly under pressure and outstanding critical thinking abilities
- Strong organizational and classroom management skills.
- Knowledge of Microsoft Office suite, Google platforms (Google Docs, Sheets, Presentations, etc) as well as experience with LMS like Blackboard, Canvas, or other online course management, assignment-posting systems.
