









### Typical Growth




## Munsey Park Kindergarten Growth Sample (Sept. – Nov. 2019)





## Shelter Rock Kindergarten Growth Sample (Sept. – Nov. 2019)




## Munsey Park Grade 1 Growth Sample (Sept. – Nov. 2019)




## Shelter Rock Grade 1 Growth Sample (Sept. – Nov. 2019)





## Munsey Park Grade 2 Growth Sample (Sept. – Nov. 2019)

#### Total 2020-2021 impact: \$626,000


\*Approximately \$47,000 of the \$129,000 total cost for District-wide PD is eligible for Title II funding. Includes summer institutes, monthly PD, & principal training.

\*\*Includes: Grades K-5 bookroom for each building, classroom libraries, Units of Study (Writing K-2), additional books, bookcases, rugs, & K-2 editing tools. Note: Reading 3-5 Units of Study pre-bought in 2019-20. Not included in totals.)

\*\*\*An increase of \$120,000 over the 2020-21 projected costs shared in 2019-20. The prior projection did not include K-2 Writing (\$15K) or a second Literacy Specialist (\$100K).
