## **Manor Alternative Program - Drug Prevention Program**

Dear Campus Administrators,

Beginning January 2019 the Manor Alternative Program, in partnership with Phoenix House Austin, will offer a drug/alcohol abuse treatment program for students with "under the influence" and "possession" placements. Parents and students must apply and be accepted into the program by Phoenix House.

## When selected:

- Students will participate in random Drug Screening
- Students will attend evening sessions M/W/F; 5:30 PM to 8:30 PM
- Family members participate in a family group on Fridays
- Locations South Austin, Round Rock
- Students can miss a session with a reasonable excuse only. If discharged, for poor attendance, the student will complete standard placement requirements.
- Successful Completion of 4 weeks at MAP AND 12 Sessions is required to return to the home campus. MAP will still provide a transition meeting.

The program is provided in English and Spanish. There is no charge to Manor ISD. Students discharged from the program for whatever reason must complete the DAEP standard placement. Forms are posted on our website. Complete the form during the hearing process and send with the traditional placement paperwork.
