Minutes of the Public Meeting, December 28, 2023

Pursuant I.C. 5-14-1.5-3, a Public Meeting Notice was prepared and posted on Tuesday, December 26, 2023, to announce a Public Meeting to be held on Thursday, December 28, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. at the F.L. O'Neal Administration Center, 310 Stadium Drive, Brownsburg, Indiana.

The Public Meeting was called to order by Ms. Jessica Heffernan, President of the Board of School Trustees of the Brownsburg Community School Corporation at 6:00 pm. Other Board members present were Mr. Eric Hylton, Mr. Mike Wells, and Mrs. Katie Dixon. Dr. Matt Freije was not in attendance. Mr. David Day, Attorney for the Board, was also present. Ms. Heffernan asked everyone to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance and to pause for a Moment of Reflection. She explained the purpose of the public hearing was to not offer a contract extension to Dr. Jim Snapp, Superintendent of the Brownsburg Community School Corporation.

Ms. Heffernan opened the meeting for public comment.

Mr. Jason Miller spoke in support of Dr. Snapp and the many things he has done for the district during his 13 year tenure.

Mr. David Weyant asked the Board for additional information regarding their desire to not extend Dr. Snapp's contract.

Dr. Jim Snapp spoke of his desire to retire at the end of the 2026-2027 school year and encouraged the Board to reconsider their recommendation to not extend his contract.

Mr. Day called for a motion of the Board to recommend they not extend the contract of Dr. Jim Snapp and serve notice to him of the same. Mr. Mike Wells moved to approve the recommendation of counsel; Mrs. Katie Dixon seconded the motion. The Board approved the motion by a vote of four (4) ayes; zero (0) nays.

There being no further actions, Ms. Heffernan called for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Wells moved to adjourn the meeting; Mrs. Dixon seconded the motion. The Board approved the motion by a vote of four (4) ayes; zero (0) nays. The public meeting closed at 6:10 p.m.
