**ENROLLMENT Steps**

1. Apply to AVC online [Application for Admission](#)
2. Meet with your Counselor to complete your Special Admit Form
3. Students under the age of 15 must meet with the Dean of Admissions
4. Apply for the California College Promise Grant (CCPG)
5. Complete the Online Orientation
6. Register for your class(es) online beginning December 1, 2021 at 8:00 a.m.

AVC DUAL ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS:

→ Total GPA of **at least 2.5**

→ **Students under the age of 15**

- ◆ Total GPA of **at least 2.8**
- ◆ Student and a parent or guardian must participate in a meeting with the Dean of Counseling, even if you have taken a class before

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**\*\*\*\*PLEASE NOTE** : In order to have credit for college classes entered on your high school transcript, the student must request an *Official Transcript* from the college after completing the class. High school counselors *do not have access* to your college grades or transcripts. Your counselor will be happy to guide you through the process of requesting your transcript when you are ready

1. **APPLY ONLINE**

- Complete an online application **EVERY TERM**
- Apply at <https://www.avc.edu/studentservices/adminrec/applyonline>
- Students must create a login and password. Students who have applied previously use their existing CCC login. After submitting the application, the student will receive a confirmation email from AVC. This email will confirm that he/she was accepted for the Spring 2022 term, provide the student's AVC ID #, myAVC account information, and next steps for enrollment.

2. **SPECIAL ADMIT FORM**

- FORWARD a copy of the AVC acceptance/confirmation email to the Counselors at [collegecenter@skusd.k12.ca.us](mailto:collegecenter@skusd.k12.ca.us)
- Your RHECC Counselor will help you complete the *AVC Special Admit Form*. High school students taking college classes must have a Special Admit form on file in order to register for classes.

This step must be completed **by November 29** in order to register on the first day of AVC Open Registration, December 1, 2021

**Complete no later than Thursday, December 16** to be able to register for Spring Term, which begins January 10, 2022 (Please keep in mind that the high school and college campuses are closed during the holiday break).

3. **MEET WITH DEAN OF COUNSELING IF UNDER 15 YEARS OF AGE**

- Students under the age of 15* - After your RHECC Counselor submits your Special Admit Form, AVC will contact your parent/guardian to schedule a meeting with the Dean of Counseling.

4. **APPLY FOR THE CALIFORNIA COLLEGE PROMISE GRANT (CCPG)**

This is a financial aid program for Community College students. If students qualify, it reduces the out-of-pocket cost to \$20 per term.

## College Promise Grant (CCPG) Application Instructions for Special Admit Students

- To be considered to have your enrollment fees waived you **must** submit a California College Promise Grant application within **5 days** of submitting your Special Admit Form.

- Follow the steps below to submit a California College Promise Grant:
  - 1. Go to <http://www.avc.edu/studentservices/finaid/bogw>
  - 2. Scroll down and click the “**OpenCCC**” link
  - 3. Login to your OpenCCC Account
  - 4. Select “**Start A New Application**”
  - 5. Select the term you are applying for
  - 6. Read all questions carefully and correctly answer all sections
  - 7. Submit your CCPG application
  - 8. You will receive an email notifying you if your application was processed successfully or if further documentation is needed
- \*\*Note:** Each student will still be responsible for the Student Representative Fee and Student Health Fee for each semester enrolled.

### 5. **COMPLETE THE ONLINE ORIENTATION**

- Go to AVC homepage, click APPLY at the top of the page, then click (3) Complete Online Orientation OR login to your MyAVC account and complete the Online Orientation there.

## 6. **REGISTER FOR CLASSES**

**December 1, 2021 at 8:00 am** - Open Registration begins for Spring 2022 term. To register for classes, you must first complete all five enrollment steps above (contact your RHECC Counselor if you have questions.)

- ★ Students will register online for classes during Open Registration using their myAVC account.
- ★ Students may enroll after December 1, only after registration documents are submitted by an RHECC Counselor and processed by the AVC Registration Office.
- ★ Students are encouraged to register early because classes may fill up quickly.
- ★ Be aware of drop dates for classes; if you do not drop within the first two weeks of class you will be responsible for all fees.
- ★ After enrollment, be sure to pay your fees. AVC will drop students DAILY for non-payment of any fees owed.

## Paying for classes

The Spring schedule of classes is now available.

**For this upcoming registration cycle, all fees are due by 11:30 p.m. the day of registration.** If your account shows a balance due, you may be dropped from your classes if it is not paid.

If your account shows a balance due you should immediately:

**1. Pay the balance:** Log into myAVC and click: Pay My Fees

Or

**2. Apply for California College Promise Grant (formerly BOG Fee Waiver):**

Students approved for the California College Promise Grant must pay any remaining balance due.

Or

**3. Set-Up a Payment Plan:** Log into myAVC and click: Set up a Payment Plan. Payment Plans are available in fall and spring for a balance of \$50 or more and require payment of a nonrefundable enrollment fee of \$20.

Once you have made a payment or received BOGG approval, log into myAVC and click: Check My Balance to make sure your balance is \$0. If you have set up a payment plan, you will see your balance reduce each time you make a payment. ***Students who have an active payment plan will not be dropped from classes***

# VC Class Formats for Fall 2021



HyFlex  
(FLX)

HyFlex (FLX) - The HyFlex (FLX) sections will be available to be attended online or in person per the instructor's approval. Students may be able to attend some meetings of this section remotely online synchronously (attendance required during the days/times listed on the schedule).



Live Online  
(OLI)

Live Online (OLI) - These are fully remote instruction lecture classes with specific days and times that will meet via Zoom or other electronic method (also known as synchronous distance education).



Hybrid  
(HYB)

Hybrid (HYB) - These classes have an in-person orientation and may also have in-person tests. All instruction will be held online.



In Person  
Face-to-Face (F2F)

In Person Face-to-Face (F2F) - These are 100% face-to-face courses.



Online  
(DEd)

Online (DEd) - These are the traditional online sections that typically list only as "ONLINE" on the schedule (also known as asynchronous distance education).



In Person Blended  
(BLE)

In Person Blended (BLE) - These classes will include in-person and online instruction. When not in the classroom, students will also learn and participate online.
