June 10th – 14th: Launch Into Space Camp

The Ramalynn Space Camp week is your child's opportunity to immerse themselves in all things related to the NASA space program. Your child will design and build rockets to launch and build life-size cardboard spaceships to dream big in!

June 17th – 21st*: Let's Visit India

*Ramalynn will be closed June 19th for Juneteenth.

Familiarize yourself with a basic knowledge of Hindu culture! Hindi at Ramalynn is a unique experience. Explore the vivid culture of India, practice yoga, learn about Ancient India, celebrate Indian festivals, cook authentic Indian food, play games, watch Bollywood films, learn about Indian music, and more! Our Hindi program will provide a refreshing break from traditional language educational environments.

June 24th – 28th: STEAM Week

This week, students will engage in various technology-based activities, gaining hands-on experience with cutting-edge technologies. They will learn to use and design 'prints' for the Cricut, a smart cutting machine, and the 3D printer, a tool used to print 3D objects. These newly acquired skills will be applied in the creation of arts and crafts projects. A computer or iPad is required each day.

July 1st – 5th: School Closed: Midsummer Break

July 8th - 12th: Life Skills

Students will be learning how to confidently navigate real life situations such as food prep, traffic safety, social etiquettes, and more! Each day will have a different theme that the students will participate in through games, puzzles, and simulations. Let's get to it!

July 15th - 19th: Fun with Math

This summer, we are introducing creative and interesting concepts which will help your child fall in love with mathematics! In this program, we will teach your student math concepts which will help them develop logical reasoning skills. Students will enjoy brain teaser activities when they unlock the reason behind math and consequently, their unlimited potential. Get ready for struggles, mistakes, challenges, games and fun things with math!

July 22nd - 26th: Abstract Art Processes

This week, we will have fun (and get messy) with process art techniques! We will squish, smooch, and splatter our way through the week and create some unique art along the way! Students will utilize a variety of artistic and household items to learn that great art can be made anywhere.
