Our Mission

Cristo Rey Atlanta Jesuit High School is a Catholic learning community that educates young people of limited economic means, of any faith or creed, to become men and women for and with others. Through a rigorous college preparatory curriculum, integrated with a relevant work study experience, students graduate prepared for college and life.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

As we approach our tenth year of educating students, there are so many things on which to reflect and be grateful. Since opening the school in 2014, we have made a significant impact in changing the trajectory of the lives of our students and their families by fulfilling our mission of providing an outstanding college-preparatory education and workplace experience to young men and women from under-resourced communities. The success of our program is proven and consequently, our recruitment process is competitive. We admitted 125 students into the class of 2026, and we are on track to welcome more this year.

Alumni from our very first Class of 2018 are now graduating from college, and they are outpacing the six-year graduation rate of low-income students. Collectively, Cristo Rey Atlanta Jesuit's 620 alumni have accomplished the following:

- 100 % acceptance into college
- Admission to top-tier institutions including Boston College, Cornell, Dartmouth, Georgetown, Georgia Tech, Michigan, Notre Dame, UGA, UPenn, UVA, and Yale
- A total of \$85 million in merit scholarship awards

Our Corporate Work Study Program is thriving with over 130 job partners in metro Atlanta. Through this unique experience, students are empowered to connect their classroom educations with real-world work experience making a significant impact on the choices they have for their future.

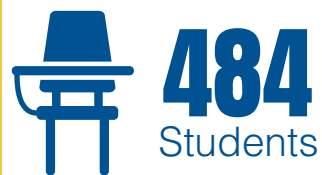

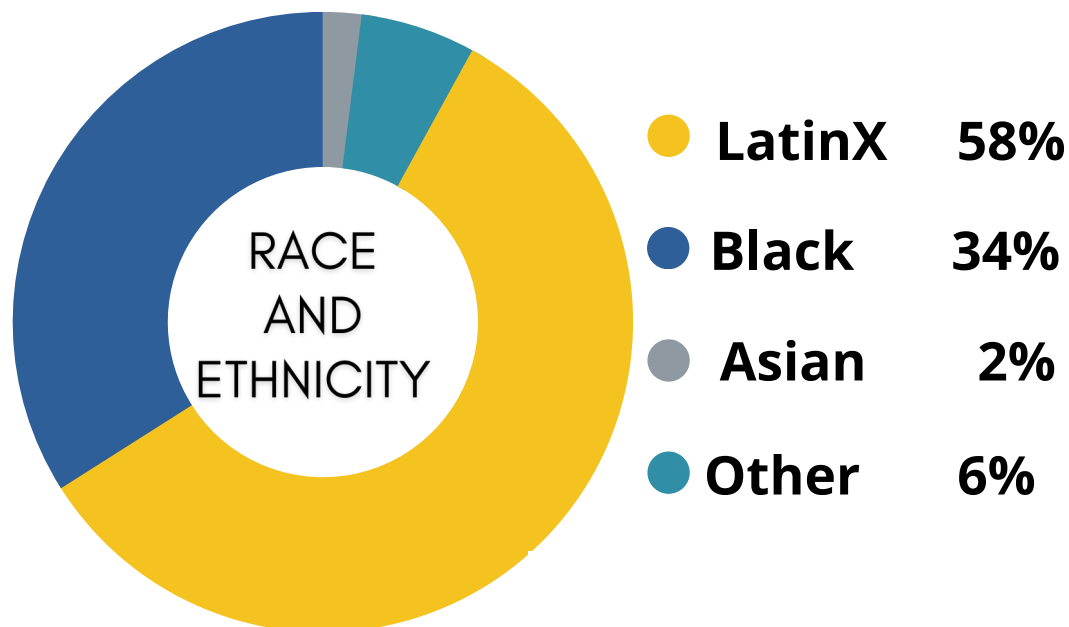

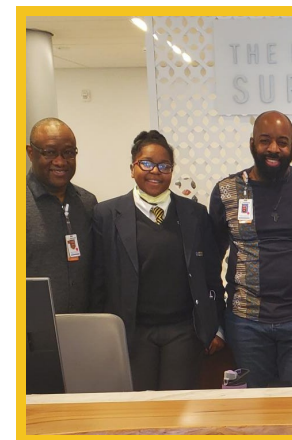

CORPORATE WORK STUDY PROGRAM

Education at Cristo Rey Atlanta Jesuit High School occurs both in the classroom and in corporate offices throughout the city. Through the innovative Corporate Work Study Program (CWSP), Cristo Rey Atlanta Jesuit High School students work 5 full days a month at top local businesses. The earnings from this work pay for a large percentage of each student's tuition costs, giving them access to a rigorous, quality college-preparatory education that otherwise would be too expensive.

Cristo Rey students also gain valuable real-world job skills, contacts, and experience through their CWSP jobs. They go on to college in record numbers, in large part because of their early exposure to the working world.

COLLEGE COUNSELING

Cristo Rey Atlanta Jesuit is dedicated to preparing our students to leave high school ready to pursue a college degree. To facilitate the transition from high school to college, we offer college counseling services and access to a network of more than 45 college and university partners.

Juniors and seniors receive college counseling to help them navigate the college application process. Support includes:

- Test preparation for the PSAT, SAT, and ACT college entrance exams
- Help filling out and submitting college applications, scholarship applications, and financial aid forms
- Individualized counseling for each junior and senior student to help them choose an appropriate college or university, and to keep them on track to graduate

All five graduating classes from Cristo Rey Atlanta Jesuit have had 100% acceptance to 4-year institutions, including Boston College, Notre Dame, Dartmouth, UGA, Georgia Tech, and Georgetown. Collectively, they have earned \$85 million in merit scholarships.

QUESTBRIDGE AND POSSE SCHOLARS

Since the first graduating class in 2018, Cristo Rey Atlanta Jesuit has had a total of 45 students accepted to the prestigious QuestBridge and Posse programs.

Through a rigorous application and interview process, students are selected for QuestBridge based on standardized test scores, course rigor and grades, class rank, extracurricular involvement, awards and honors, as well as financial circumstances in their household. QuestBridge provides full tuition to a 4-year partner college as well as covering expenses for room and board, books, and travel.

Through a nomination process as well as outstanding academic potential and leadership, students are selected for the Posse scholarship. Posse covers the expense of room and board at a 4-year partner institution.
