- 7) Pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation and/or matters of attorney-client privilege
- 8) Specific prospective or current employees unless all who could be adversely affected request an open session
- 9) Deliberation after a public hearing that could result in a civil penalty or other loss

Be it further resolved that the Board will adjourn into Executive Session to conduct interviews, and upon conclusion will meet in Public Session where action may be taken:
