TVS Music does not fall under the Auxiliary Programs umbrella – due to their significant work during the school day – although certain TVS Music operations happen after school.

- After-school orchestra practices are only open to students taking individual TVS Music strings lessons.
- Orchestra practices will occur in the Great Hall Foyer at 3:45-4:45, and dismissal will be at the Great Hall Circle (so as not to conflict with Auxiliary Program dismissal at the Lower School Circle).
- From 3:30-3:45, participants are expected to come to the TVS Dining Hall for a snack (provided). Although students will keep their instruments with them, they should not play or tune their instruments in the TVS Dining Hall.
- Students are encouraged to come to orchestra practice at least once per week, but can attend more frequently, if desired. There will be a "loose RSVP form" provided by TVS Music staff. Whereas there is much flexibility in these orchestra practices, the form will enable our team to see approximate daily attendance numbers.

We realize that other after-school opportunities – beyond those listed in this chart – may exist. These may include sports clubs and theater productions, among other activities. Please contact our team if you have any questions, and we'll be happy to point you in the right direction!

Our Enrichment programs are carefully designed experiences that aim to expand and enrich students' academic, creative, and athletic horizons. As such, we request that families register in a timely fashion (prior to the start of each program), so that each child gets the best experience possible! Our instructors have much to offer!

All programs begin after Martin Luther King Jr. Day.

- Please pay special attention to the specific dates of the programs. Some programs do not begin until the week
  of March 18.
- If you see an expected date "missing," this indicates either a no-school day OR a day the instructor is unavailable.
- Trinity Valley School is not responsible for weather-related cancellations. Whereas we certainly try to minimize these last-minute cancellations, we appreciate your understanding if / when they occur! We will notify registered families of any such cancellations via email.

Registration for programs will occur online, via the <u>Auxiliary Programs registration platform</u>, powered by CampBrain. Registration opens on **Wednesday**, **November 8**, **2023**, **at 5:00 p.m.** All participants – both from Trinity Valley School and the broader community – must register online.

All programs have an enrollment minimum and maximum; these specific numbers vary by program.

- If a minimum enrollment is not met, we may be forced to cancel the program. We will aim to do this well in advance of the program start date, so registered families have time to pursue other options.
- If a maximum enrollment is exceeded, our platform will automatically switch the program status to "waitlisting." You are welcome to add your child's name to the waitlist, or find other programs that are still open. If space opens in a waitlisted program, a member of the Auxiliary Programs team will contact you as soon as possible to inquire about finalizing enrollment. Please note that we may not be able to accommodate all waitlisted individuals.

A 15-minute supervised break for restroom, water, and snack (provided) will occur in the TVS Dining Hall between school-day dismissal and the start of Enrichment programs that begin by 3:45 p.m.

- We will use the <u>Auxiliary Programs registration platform</u> for program registration and en mass family communications.
  - However, billing for Enrichment programs will occur via the FACTS portal (for TVS families) or via paper check (for non-TVS families). For more information, please see the blue chart on p. 4 of this Catalog.
  - It is required for all participants to register online for Enrichment programs.
  - During the registration process, families will be required to agree with the Spring 2024 Enrichment waivers and releases. A copy of these waivers and releases may be found here.
  - o All programs have an enrollment minimum and maximum; these specific numbers vary by program.
    - If a minimum enrollment is not met, we may be forced to cancel the program. We will aim to do this well in advance of the program start date, so registered families have time to pursue other options.
    - If a maximum enrollment is exceeded, our platform will automatically switch the program status to "waitlisting." You are welcome to add your child's name to the waitlist, or find other programs that are still open. If space opens in a waitlisted program, a member of the Auxiliary Programs team will contact you as soon as possible to inquire about finalizing enrollment. Please note that we may not be able to accommodate all waitlisted individuals.
- All participants must be 4 years of age or older and thoroughly independent in the restroom.
- Our programs are designed to follow the scheduling rhythms of Trinity Valley School. Whereas we welcome non-TVS students to participate in our Enrichment programs, we are not able to provide transportation to / from our campus.
  - Non-TVS families must drop off their participants in the TVS Dining Hall by the start of the program and pick up their participants from the TVS Dining Hall at the end of the program. No Extended Day programming is available to non-TVS families.
