



This program will train students to assist physicians by performing functions related to the clinical responsibilities of a medical office. Instruction includes preparing patients for examination & treatment, routine lab procedures, diagnostic testing, technical aspects of the cardiac life cycle; includes 194 hours of classroom lecture/hands on labs plus clinical externship opportunity. To be eligible for clinical rotation, students must successfully complete 194hour academic program, submit to a thorough background check, drug screening and other requirements. Note: Upon successful completion of this program, students are be eligible to sit for the National Certified Clinical Medical Assistant national examination. Incoming students are required to be CPR certified prior to clinical rotation start. Background clearances, and other prerequisites must be satisfied prior to first night of class at student's expense. Classroom Program runs Jan 17-May 22, 2024; 3 evenings a week and alternate Saturdays. Clinical Externship immediately follows classroom training and requires daylight hours.
