The University City High School Counseling Office provides a comprehensive school counseling program offering support in academics, college and career placement, financial aid, college counseling and well-being counseling through individualized planning and responsive services. The office has an open-door policy for students. Students have multiple spaces in the office where they can work on applications, resumes or other necessary projects with professional support from the counseling team, a social worker and a therapist. Students are encouraged to visit the office starting freshman year to learn and utilize the services and opportunities that are available to them throughout their high school journey.

Academic Counseling Services

- Individual academic planning and advisement
- Individual Career and Academic Plan development (ICAP)
- Assistance with course selection and scheduling

Responsive Services/Well-Being Services

- Students provided with resources to address personal concerns that interfere with healthy social/emotional, academic and career development
- On campus individual therapy to address emotional and behavioral issues from Lutheran Family and Children's Services
- Wyman's Teen Connection Project provides wellness support for students including emotional regulations, peer relationships, decision making and more

College Counseling Services

- Students are offered offered an opportunity during the Spring semester of their Junior year to take the ACT test paid for by the school district
- FAFSA support for students and families including annual FAFSA Frenzy night
- College essay coaching in collaboration with the English Language Arts teachers
- Annual UCHS College and Career Fair featuring local, regional and national colleges/universities and employers
- Office visits from college and career admission representatives each school year
- Annual free UCHS group visits to Missouri colleges and universities have included Harris-Stowe University, Southeast Missouri State University, University of Missouri - Columbia, University of Missouri - St. Louis, Washington University in St. Louis and Webster University
- Missouri A+ designated school that supports students through community service opportunities and provides qualified graduates with scholarship resources to Missouri public colleges and universities

Career Counseling Services

- WorkKeys certification program to place students in professional trade training and positions both in and after high school
- Project Lead the Way course opportunities in engineering and biomedical science
- Interview coaching
- Access to paid summer internships through NAF
- Transition to Work Academy provides students with entry level credentials and connects them with potential employers

Early College Experience

- Early College Experience in partnership with St. Louis Community College to simultaneously earn an associate's degree and a high school diploma upon graduation
- Dual credit classes are available to eligible students beginning their sophomore year
