ATTENDANCE LETTERS

Please note that beginning this Friday, January 5, a letter will be emailed home to all WPS families, via PowerSchool, showing your child's updated attendance record. Going forward, this will occur on the first Friday of each month.

You may check your child's attendance in PowerSchool at any time, however, these monthly reminders will start being sent home to help each family track their child's absences. The State of Connecticut considers a child "Truant" when they have four (4) unexcused absences in a 30 day period or ten (10) unexcused absences in a school year. For this reason, our attendance records in PowerSchool must be up-to-date and accurate. More information will be provided in the monthly email, but please make note of the coming letters.

REMINDERS

CAFETERIA CHANGES

Beginning on January 12, 2024, Chartwells will be upgrading the Point of Sale (POS) system in the cafeteria. This new system will assist the district in increasing the level of security and service provided. When the system is implemented, students will no longer use their school ID for cafeteria purchases. Students will be issued a new five (5) digit code that is not associated with their school ID. At SES, students will have a scan card with their new code that is scanned when they purchase items.
