She holds leadership roles on a number of boards including the Girl Scouts, the Jewish Community Center, the Jewish Federation, the United Way, the Variety Club, Webster University and the Missouri Historical Society.

As strong supporters of Washington

University in St. Louis, Fox and her husband, Sam Fox, were awarded the 2004 Jane and Whitney Harris Saint Louis Community Service Award which recognized their extraordinary generosity and leadership. Also in 2004, the couple received the Arts and Education Council Excellence in Philanthropy Award. Fox received a Women of Achievement Award in 1993 and was named the Variety Club's Woman of the Year in 1996. She has also been honored by the Jewish Federation and the National Conference of Community and Justice. Additionally, she and her husband were jointly awarded an honorary doctorate in public service from St. Louis University in 2000.
