

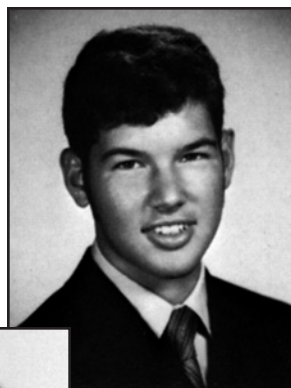

Joel Goldstein went on to graduate summa cum laude from Princeton University and from Oxford University as a Rhodes Scholar. He received his law degree from Harvard Law

School. For 12 years, he practiced law with the St. Louis firm of Goldstein and Price and is currently Professor of Law at Saint Louis University, where he teaches Admiralty, Contracts, Constitutional Law I, and Federal Jurisdiction, as well as a seminar on the Constitution and the Vice President.
