*Class of 1959*

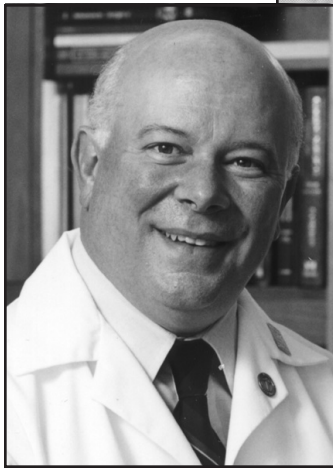
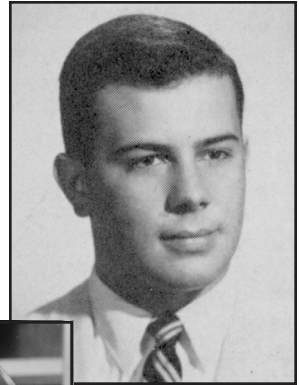
Dr. Ira Kodner's curriculum vitae gives a brief, but impressive overview of his career as a successful surgeon.

Clinical Instructor in Surgery, Clinical Assistant Professor of Surgery, Chief for Section of Colon and Rectal Surgery, and Associate Professor of Surgery. Of course, Dr. Kodner began his relationship with Washington University while doing his undergraduate, graduate, and post-graduate work.
