William Kohn

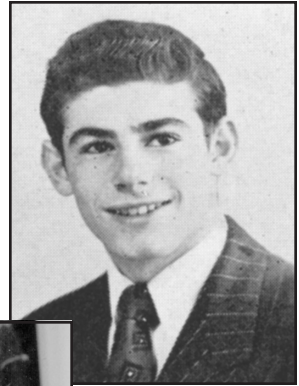
