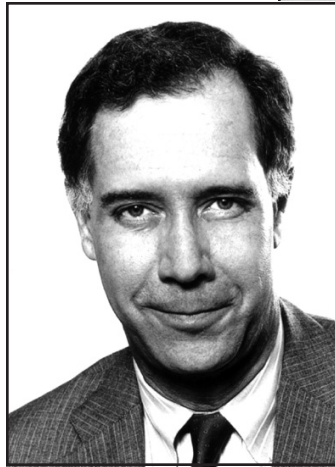
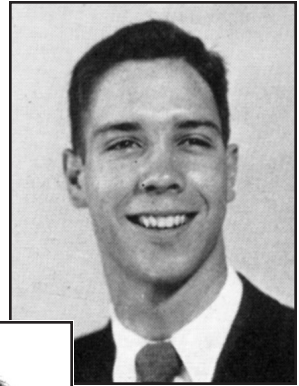
Jason McManus

Jason McManus was the fourth editor-in-chief for Time Warner Inc., the world's largest media and entertainment company.

He began his career in 1957 with an internship with *Sports Illustrated* magazine. He returned the following summer as a trainee and joined the company full time in 1959 as a writer for *Time* magazine's world section.

Beginning in 1962, McManus covered European politics from Paris for two years. After returning to the United States, he held various prestigious positions. Twenty-one years later, he became *Time's* managing editor. Two years later, he was named editor-in-chief designate. He is now fully retired and lives in Manhattan with his wife.
