
Wiley Price

His photographs have resulted in awards from the Missouri Press Association, Illinois Press Association, National Newspaper Publishers Association, Greater St. Louis Association of Black Journalists and the Suburban Newspapers of America. He has been recognized by such civic organizations as Missouri's Martin Luther King Jr. State Celebration Commission, the United Way of Greater St. Louis and the Annie Malone Children and Family Service Center.
