## CARPOOL

Dismissal times for camps differ per week and per camp. Times can be 2 p.m., 3 p.m. or 4 p.m. (depending on your registration that week). If pick up is designated at any other time, please park and walk inside to the front desk to check out your child.



## WHAT TO WEAR, WHAT TO BRING/LUNCH

Campers should wear tennis shoes and comfortable clothing. Campers should wear sunblock.

## FEES/CANCELLATION

Parents must complete a separate online registration for each child. Camp fees vary per week depending on the activity. All fees must be paid at the time of registration. **A \$50 non-refundable registration fee is included in each camp fee. Cancellation of camp must be made no later than the Friday, nine days prior to the Monday of the start of camp, to receive a 100 percent refund (minus the registration fee).** Refunds are not available for cancellations made during the week of camp or the week prior to camp.

No refund will be granted if you cancel later than nine days prior to the start of camp. No moving registration to another week will be granted within the same 9 days prior to the start of the camp window.

## REGISTRATION

All registrations must be made online. You can find the online registration on the Summer Camp tab found under Programs on the main St. Martin's Episcopal School webpage. Visit <https://www.stmartinschool.org/programs/summerholiday-camps>. Registration is available until the Thursday night prior to the start of camp.

## AFTER CAMP UNTIL 5:30 P.M.
