Re: Changes to the Health and Physical Education Curriculum Implementation

In the spring of 2023, the health and physical education departments met regarding anticipated changes to their curriculum implementation. Currently (2023-2024) students are required to enroll in a .25 credit health and a .25 credit physical education class each year. In doing so, students meet the FPS graduation requirements policy 6146 when the courses are successfully completed (i.e., 1.0 credit(s) in each).

In order to better schedule the health and physical education credit each year, starting in the 2024-2025 school year, we will offer half (.50) credit course each year. This will allow students to take additional electives throughout high school.

The 2024-2025 school year will be a transition year. Thus, students currently in grades 9 and 11 will be offered the quarter credit next year. This will complete the current requirements of the .25 or .75 accumulated credit(s). Students entering grade 9 and 11 next year (current grade 8 and 10 students) will only be offered the half credit course next year.


