



Application Instructions

- 1) A paper application must be turned into Mrs. Lee (room 3104) before the deadline, **Friday, January 26th @ 8:00AM**
 - a) There are NO exceptions to this deadline as per CSF By-Laws.
 - b) TYPE the application. Do NOT handwrite the application. The application is a “fill-in pdf”.
 - c) Sign the “application received list” when you turn-in your application to Mrs. Lee (room 3104)

- 2) Properly fill in the application. READ these directions.
 - a) Use this pdf or download the pdf application (<http://jserra.org/csf>) on your computer. DO NOT download as a Google Doc.
 - b) Open the pdf, use your mouse to click on the blanks, type in information. Save pdf and print the last page only.
 - c) Look at your last report card. Make sure you have NO “D’s or F’s” from **Fall 2023 semester grades**.
 - d) Make sure to list only 3-5 courses. DO NOT WRITE all your classes.
 - e) Make sure the courses are from the appropriate list (List I, II, III).
 - f) 3 points for A’s. 1 point for B’s. 1 extra point for listed AP or Honors courses with a max of 2 extra points.
 - g) Make sure that the subtotal and/or total points for your courses meet the requirement (minimum for total is 10 points but subtotals must meet minimums of 4 and 7 points).

- 3) Previous members: all service hours should have been recorded on X2VOL - CSF JSerra (group)
New applicants: no service hours required yet until AFTER membership is granted.

- 4) Notification of membership acceptance will be **emailed** to your jserra.org address by Wednesday, January 31st, 2024.
 - a) Verification of semester grades determines membership.
 - b) Code to submit the \$10 semester dues will be emailed AFTER acceptance into CSF.
 - c) See info on website <https://www.jserra.org/lion-life/clubs/csf> regarding semester membership and active semester membership.
 - d) If accepted as a CSF member, the 1st meeting will be Monday, February 5th in the Center Room at 2:45. A meeting scheduled will be emailed with notification of membership acceptance. (Most meetings are scheduled for the 1st Monday of each month). If missing a meeting, email reason for excused absence for meeting to csf@jserra.org. Email must include reason and a contact email address of person who can verify.

CSF points are granted as follows:

- Grade of **A** = 3 CSF points
- Grade of **B** = 1 CSF points
