

2024 Tri Kappa Scholarship Tri Town Zeta Psi Chapter

Tri Kappa is a philanthropic sorority that promotes charity, culture, and education in Indiana communities. The purpose of the Tri Town Zeta Psi Chapter Scholarships is to recognize Tri Town students who demonstrate a commitment to both community service and educational pursuits.

Tri Town Tri Kappa will award scholarships of **\$2,000** each to six (6) outstanding graduating high school seniors, who are planning to continue their education at either a four-year college/university or vocational school. Eligible students, who meet the criteria and are selected by the committee, are to have excelled in volunteer and community service while maintaining good academic standing. Applicants must have their home address in **Dyer, Schererville, or Saint John, Indiana, or reside within the geographical boundaries of the Lake Central School Corporation** and **must be in the top 25% of their graduating class**. In addition, students **must be able to show community service and/or volunteer activities in their community**.

Please indicate the scholarship for which you are applying:

 College/University Scholarship – Eligible candidate is a high school senior who is continuing his/her education at a four-year college or university.

 Vocational School/Career Training Scholarship – Eligible candidate is a high school senior who is continuing his/her education at a vocational school or other institution.

Requirements:

- ❖ **Personal Essay:** In 100-150 words, this essay should be a review of your past 4 years of high school, including any volunteer activities you were involved with. Please include a preview of your goals for your future.
- ❖ **Two Letters of Recommendation:** One letter must be from a faculty member of your high school whose class you were enrolled in. Other options may include employers, family members, clergy, or others you might know.
- ❖ **High School Transcript:** Transcript must include first semester grades of applicant's senior year.
- ❖ **Completed Scholarship Application:** Award winners must sign and return a scholarship agreement, which obligates the winner to furnish the Tri Kappa Scholarship Committee with a copy of their college/vocational school's first semester grades. Once received, Tri Kappa will disburse the awarded scholarship. Failure to furnish a copy of the student's first semester grades will forfeit the award.

Application Deadline: Applications and all requirements must be postmarked or emailed on or before **April 6, 2024**.
