

Angie and Eric Douglas Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Angie and Eric Douglas, children of Mark and Pam Douglas. Angie graduated from Athens High School in 2001 and attended Ohio University, graduating in 2005 with a Bachelor's Degree in Early Childhood Education. Angie fulfilled her dream by being hired as a teacher at Alexander Elementary School just prior to her passing. Angie died as the result of a motorcycle accident on June 27, 2005. Eric graduated from Athens High School in 2004 and attended Ohio University, graduating in 2008 with a Bachelor's Degree in the College of Engineering and Technology. Eric was employed at Miba Bearings as an Applications Engineer. Eric died as the result of injuries received in an auto accident on February 16, 2016.

Two students will be selected to receive a \$500 scholarship. Application is open to all students. First preference will be given to students planning to attend Ohio University, majoring in early childhood education or engineering. This scholarship will be awarded on even years. A check will be forwarded to the school upon notification of enrollment of the recipient.
