Check application due dates for four-year colleges.

- UC application
  - Opens August 1 and due November 30

- CSU application
  - Most are due November 30; please check website
  - <https://www.calstate.edu/apply>
- Private and Out-of-States Colleges
  - Check Common Application and must link to Naviance and waive your rights
  - Deadlines vary from school to school <https://www.commonapp.org>
  - Need a letter of recommendation from college counselors or school report needs to be submitted by college counselors
    - You must match your Naviance account with your Common App account!
    - You must waive your rights (FERPA)

## Pierce College Application

## FAFSA- Financial Aid information

- File the FAFSA or the CA Dream Act Opens October 1. Priority deadlines is March 2, 2023

## Important Fall semester information

- Don't forget to continually check your email and your portals. The colleges will communicate with you through the email you provided or through the portals you set up
  - They may ask you to send transcripts; only send it if they ask you
- Pass your classes and keep up your grades. Colleges will look at your senior grades/classes and they can rescind any acceptances.
- Do not change your spring semester classes after you apply. If you do, then you need to report those changes to all the schools you applied to.
- May 1 is the deadline for you to decide which four-year college you want to attend. You may hear from most schools during March to April.
- You will have to order final transcripts to be sent to the ONE SCHOOL you will end up going to. This will be done in May.
