GPAs

Overall ECR GPA

- All classes count towards this GPA
- Only AP classes get an extra point (C or higher)
- Associated with class ranks
- GPA used for private and out of state schools
- Schools on the Common
 App will use the overall GPA

UC/CSU GPA

- UC's and CSU's only take your
 10th and 11th grade classes into account for your GPA
- You should still do your best in 12th grade because it may affect your acceptance
- UC's use weighted GPA
 meaning that you get an extra
 point for every UC approved
 Honors and AP courses
- Only 8 semesters of Honors or AP classes count towards the UC GPA. Only two for 10th grade year.

SAT vs ACT

- Colleges are:
 - Test optional
 - Test Flexible
 - They want you to turn in a test in but you don't have to.
 - Test blind
 - UCs/Cal states=BLIND
- Every institution has their own policies. Be sure to check
- UC & CSU is test blind for Class of 2024. This means that even if you submit scores, they will not use it.
- Private and out of state schools may still either require it or be test optional. But it is not a requirement. You need to check individual colleges if they need it.

SAT vs ACT

• SAT

- 400 1600 is range of score (1600 is highest)
- 200 800 pts for Reading & Writing
 - Reading: 5 passages (literature, 2 science, 2 history/social studies)
- 200 800 pts for Math (2 sections: no calculator and calculator)
 - 45 MCQ and 13 stu-produced response questions
 - fewer geometry questions; more word problems, data analysis and emphasis on Algebra.

• ACT

- 1 36 is high score (36 is highest)
- 1 36 for ALL sections: Reading, English, Math, and Science
 - Reading: 4 passages (prose/fiction, social sci., humanities, natural sci.)
 - Math: lots of Geometry

- Application opens Aug. 1 Nov. 30

 - You choose 4 out of 8

- Describe an example of your leadership experience in which you have positively influenced others, helped resolve disputes, or contributed to a group efforts over time.
- Every person has a creative side, and it can be expressed in many ways: problem solving, original and innovative thinking, and erratically, to name a few. Describe how you express your creative side
- Describe a significant challenge you have faced and the steps you have taken to overcome this challenge. How has this challenge affected your academic achievement?
- Think about an academic subject that inspires you. Describe how you have furthered this interest inside and/or outside of the classroom
- Pick 4 out of 8
- Max of 350 words for each
- Try to show different dimensions of the student
- Answer the questions like you are being asked these questions in an interview

- 4 year college
- Common App opens Aug. 1
- https://www.commonapp.org/
- Application deadlines vary.*
 - Check your deadlines!!!
- Holistic Review
 - Transcripts, extracurriculars, and awards information are required
 - SAT or ACT may be required
 - Supplemental Essays (extra essay)
 - Letters of Recommendation are required: 1 college counselor & 2 teachers (request teachers through Naviance)
- You must fill out a recommendation packet

What is the rec packet?


- Pick up a recommendation packet from the office or go to College & Career Tab to download packet
- In order to ask your teachers for recommendation, you must match your Common App to your Naviance
- Ask your teacher if he/she needs a copy of the recommendation packet

CSU

California State University

- 4 year college
- 2.50 minimum
- There are 23 CSU campuses
- Application opens Oct. 1 Nov. 30
- https://www.calstate.edu/apply
- Straightforward application
 - No essay required
 - No extracurriculars required
 - No letter of rec









CSU

What is IMPACTION?

- Our local Cal State is CSUN
- If you apply to CSUN with 2.65* or higher and with a nonimpacted major, you will meet the eligibility index
- You need a higher GPA for any impacted majors
- Impacted majors from Fall 2024: Accounting, Biology, Business Administration - options in Financial Analysis, Financial Planning and Risk Management, Cinema and Television Arts, Kinesiology, Music (Audition), Psychology

The major you pick for CSU may be important

Community College

- "2 year" college
 - You can transfer to UC, CSU, Priv., Out of State after 2 years (about 60 credits)
- Only requirements: High School diploma and/or 18 years of age
- Opens anywhere from October to Spring semester
- Promise Program
 - Must file FAFSA or Dream Act and take summer program to qualify
- TAG Program
- Some CC offers <u>bachelor's degree</u> (Cerritos, LA Valley)
- Transfer rates to competitive schools are higher than freshmen admit
- Pierce Rep is here every Thursday 9:30 to 1

Financial Aid

FAFSA / Dream Act

- FAFSA & Dream Act Opens tentatively Dec 1
- Priority deadline: March 2
- Need parent/guardian tax info (using 2022 tax year)
- You will need to file a FAFSA/Dream Act for Promise Program
- "ALL-IN"- ALL 12th graders need to submit FAFSA or Dream Act (AB 469)
- Financial Aid Night offered- check website

How to create a balanced list

Safety-Target-Reach

You must consider:

- Location
- Distance
- Extracurricular Activities Available
- Student Life
- Campus Size
- Student Diversity

Create a balanced list:

- **Reach Schools** Your GPA generally fall at or below the school's acceptance rate and/or the acceptance rate is less than 25%.
- **Target Schools** Your GPA fits the school's acceptance rate and the acceptance rate is around 25%-75%.
- Safety (backup) Schools Your GPA is above the school's acceptance rate and the acceptance rate is 75% or higher.

Have more target schools than reach schools!

Other College Tips

- Keep track of deadlines
 - This includes recommendation packet deadlines if you want an interview
 - Know deadlines of either Early Action (EA) and Early Decision (ED)
- Check Naviance for scholarship opportunities
- Check school assigned emails and school social media platforms for upcoming events.
 i.e. college visits, Senior Workshops, etc.
- Unsure of post HS options, speak with your assigned College Career Counselor
