## Volunteer Handbook Acknowledgement

Your application is complete when you submit the Volunteer Application and Volunteer Handbook Acknowledgement Form (three pages) with a copy of your photo ID. We will review your completed application and conduct a Washington State Patrol background check which can take 5-7 days to process. Be sure to complete your application well in advance of the day you wish to begin volunteering. After your application is processed, you will receive an email notification of the status. You cannot volunteer or provide services in ANY capacity until this notice is received. Approval is valid for two years. There are federal and state laws that protect the privacy rights of students and families. In a school situation, there are many instances in which confidential information is discussed to better understand students and how we can help them. When working in the schools as a volunteer, there may be times when this information is heard. Our staff will make every effort to prevent this from happening; however, as a volunteer you must agree that if you do hear information about a student, staff member, or family you will not repeat this information. This will ensure the protection of our students' interests and their families, thus creating a better environment for all.

Additionally, two laws govern confidentiality: FERPA (Family Education Rights and Privacy Act) and IDEIA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act). Both regulations indicate that confidentiality must be maintained relative to all students. Therefore, any written or verbal communication with anyone who does not have a right to know is in violation of the laws. A volunteer should not discuss (written or verbal) a child's educational needs, information, or experiences with any individual. Only those who work directly with the student are considered those who "need to know." If at any time these terms of confidentiality are violated by a volunteer, the person will be no longer be allowed to volunteer in our schools.
