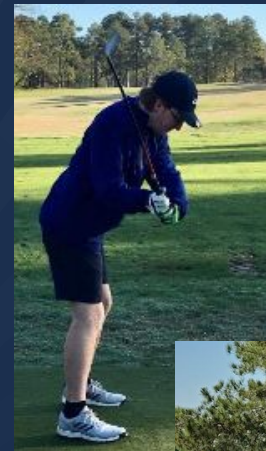
# Panther Pride- Extracurriculars

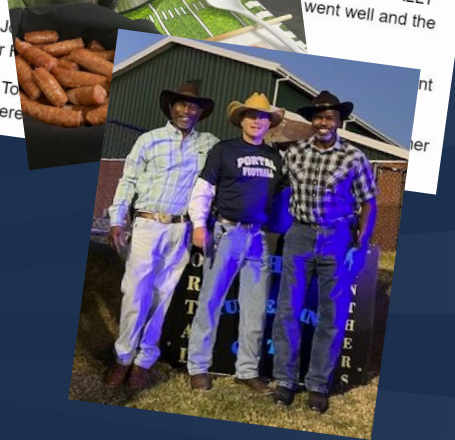
