

### Class Rank/Highest-Ranking Student (Secondary Grade Levels Only)

- Class Rank and Honors will be awarded in the following procedure:
  - All classes will be coded as regular classes. All grades will be averaged to determine class rank, Valedictorian, and Salutatorian. Any class opposite of athletics for grades 10-12 and College Prep English Language Arts (amended Jan. 2022) will not be calculated into class rank. Students who elect to take dual credit will receive 10 additional points per dual credit course. For example a student making a 90 will receive a 100 for the course. A dual credit course will be any course that is approved by the principal and requires the passage of the TSI test. Any dual credit course that does not require passage of the TSI will not receive the 10 additional points. Points will be awarded for grades over 100. High School classes taken in Junior High may not be included in the numerical average.
  - For purposes of class rank for the graduation ceremony, GPA's will be calculated at the end of the 5<sup>th</sup> six weeks and current dual credit grades will be calculated in at the 5<sup>th</sup> six weeks.
  - Final GPA rankings will occur after the 6<sup>th</sup> six weeks is complete.
