\* The annual rate is granted when families pay in full by June 1, 2024 or in two equal installments due June 1st and December 1st.

\*\* Families with more than one child will receive a 10% discount for the second student per family and a 20% discount for the third student per family. The fourth child and over are free.

\*\*\* Students may be required to purchase school supplies and other materials required by their grade level. High School students are responsible for purchasing their own textbooks and any other AP fees.

\*\*\*\* To receive the Catholic Rate, you must meet all requirements of the church where you practice your Catholic faith. You must submit the Pastor Recommendation Form as part of your child enrollment. You will be responsible for the amount your church does not subsidize.
