Use your toys at home and create a maze! Draw it on a piece of paper, or take a picture of it!	Play a board game with someone.	Draw a picture and describe what the weather is like today. Practice counting forwards and backwards from any random number to 120.
Grab 10 items around your house. Have an important person at home take something away, can you remember what is missing? Try with 10 new things!	Set a timer and see how quickly you and a partner can complete a task. Clean a room, fold the laundry, wash the dishes or ??	Collect some snow from outside. Make some into a snowball and leave some loose on a plate. Time how long it takes for each to melt. Compare the times.	Read a book to a pet or stuffed animal. Be sure to practice using expression!	Practice your addition facts through 12 using flash cards. If you don't have any, make some!
Color or draw a picture. Cut into puzzle pieces. Have fun putting it together!	Play a game of tag/hide and seek with the neighbor kids or siblings.	Build a tower. How tall is it? How wide is it? How strong is it? What can you change to make it stronger?	Write your sight words on paper pieces. Crunch it up and shoot it into a bowl or a basket!	Ask an adult if you can count, sort and/or identify the coins in their pocket or purse.
