# **NEWS FROM THE NURSE:**

**CHILDHOOD ILLNESSES OF VOMITING, DIARRHEA AND FEVERS ARE COMMON IN CHILDREN. BEFORE RETURNING TO SCHOOL, YOUR CHILD SHOULD GO AT LEAST 24 HOURS OR LONGER WITHOUT SYMPTOMS.**

**THIS MEANS THAT THEY SHOULD NOT HAVE ANY EPISODES OF VOMITING OR DIARRHEA OR FEVER FOR 24 HOURS OR MORE. RETURNING TO THEIR NORMAL BASELINE OF EATING A REGULAR DIET AND PLAYING LIKE THEIR USUAL SELF IS ALSO RECOMMENDED. FOR FEBRILE ILLNESSES, MAKE SURE THAT YOUR CHILD IS FEVER-FREE FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS WITHOUT THE USE OF FEVER-REDUCING MEDICATION LIKE TYLENOL OR ADVIL. FOLLOWING THE 24-HOUR RULE WILL HELP CUT DOWN ON THE RISK OF SPREADING CONTAGIOUS ILLNESSES. HANDWASHING IS THE SINGLE MOST IMPORTANT THING WE CAN DO TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF ILLNESS.**
