Please remember, the pull-out area in front of the school should only be utilized for dropping off and picking up students in kindergarten. We have noticed an increase of families using this as a parking space and it is creating a hazard for our pick-up and drop-off procedures. Our traffic committee has worked extremely hard to create a safer pick-up/drop-off system and we truly appreciate your support in following the guidelines. Students in 1st-6th grade should be dropped-off/picked-up on 20th East while kindergarten students (and siblings) should use 1900 East. We are working on providing more adult support during pick-up so parents can remain in their car, thus reducing the amount of time you need to be in the pull-out area.
