Seclusion Rooms Available Description: Salem-Keizer Public Schools has (1) seclusion room that meets all state standard requirements. The seclusion room is located at the Behavior Intervention Center (BIC), which supports our students with the most complex social-emotional and behavioral needs. The seclusion room is only used after all less restrictive interventions have been exhausted and the student either poses a serious health and safety risk to themselves, other students, or staff.
