Fine Arts	Student Engagement	Community Service
<p>Earn four high school credits in fine arts <u>and</u> participate in 8 outside fine arts events during a student's high school career, i.e. 2 events per year for 4 years.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Fine Arts credit could include Band, Choir, Visual Art, Art History, Music Theory, CCP Music Courses, Instrumental Courses (Piano, Guitar, etc.) ● Outside fine arts events are related to participation outside of the graded course of study ● Completion of Fine Arts Seal Outside Event Documentation Form, verified by fine arts teacher/advisor for each outside event and approved by school administration 	<p>Complete 4 seasons of student engagement activities during a student's high school career.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● A season is defined from "start to end" of an activity. ● May include but is not limited to athletic teams, school clubs, 4-H, church youth group, etc. ● Completion of the Student Engagement Seal Activity Documentation Form, verified by coach/advisor for each activity and approved by school administration 	<p>Complete a community service project during a student's high school career.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Community Service Project should include a portfolio that includes documentation of hours and self-reflection of experiences ● A <u>minimum</u> of 40 total documented hours ● Students are responsible for obtaining the hours through the school or outside opportunity ● Completion of the Community Service Project Documentation Form, verified by supervisor and approved by school administration

Examples of Fine Arts Outside Events:

- I. Solo and Ensemble Contest
 - * 1 or 2 rating approved
 - * 3 at director discretion
- II. Honor/Independent Ensemble or Musical Production Participation
 - 1. District XI Honor Ensemble
 - 2. OHC Honor Ensemble
 - 3. Any college sanctioned Honor Ensemble
 - 4. Any college hosted Workshop
 - 5. Professional hosted Workshop
 - 6. OMEA State Ensembles (Band, Choir, Jazz, Orchestra)
 - 7. All Star Brass Band (Columbus)
 - 8. Springfield Youth Symphony
 - 9. Drum Corps International
 - 10. Ohio State Fair band or choir
 - 11. All Ohio FFA Band
 - 12. All Ohio FFA Choir
 - 13. Church or other establishment ensemble
 - 14. Participation in school musical
 - a. Home or neighboring school district
 - b. Acting, Pit Orchestra, or Stage Crew
 - 15. Other ensembles with director approval prior to participation
- III. Private Lessons
 - * Music, Dance, Twirl, etc.
 - * 20 documented hours (total of all lessons combined)
 - * Qualified instructor (approved by teacher of record)

Examples of Student Engagement Activities:

- 1. Athletic Teams - Baseball, Basketball, Bowling, Cheerleading, Cross Country, Football, Golf, Soccer, Softball, Swimming, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball, Wrestling, etc.
- 2. School Clubs - French Club, Spanish Club, National Honor Society, PBIS Team, Quiz Team, Student Council, etc.
- 3. Career & Technical Student Organizations (CTSOs) - BPA, DECA, FCCLA, FFA, HOSA, Skills USA, etc.
- 4. County 4-H Programs
- 5. Church Youth Groups

Examples of Community Service Projects:

- 1. Neighborhood enhancement program
- 2. Help serve meals at a homeless shelter
- 3. Adopt a friend at a nursing home
- 4. Volunteer with Special Olympics
- 5. Serve at a food bank
- 6. Paint park/playground items, with prior permission/approval
- 7. Organize a community clean-up project
- 8. Volunteer as a youth coach or referee
- 9. Assist at an animal shelter
