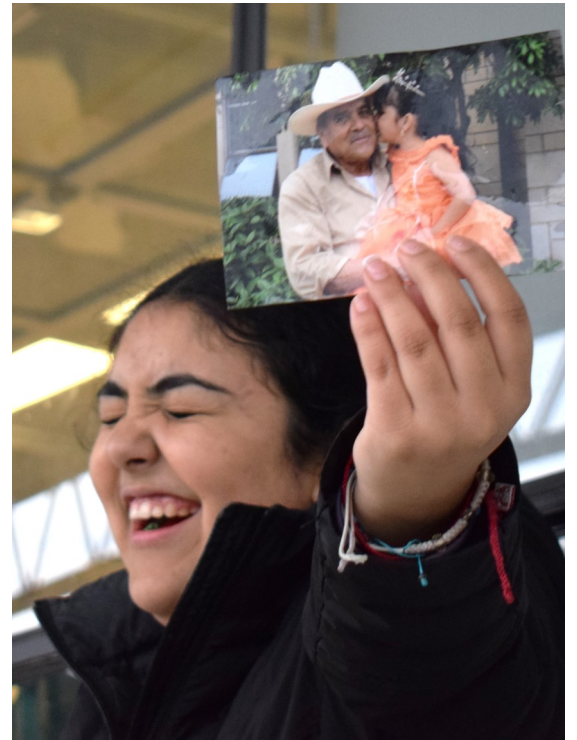

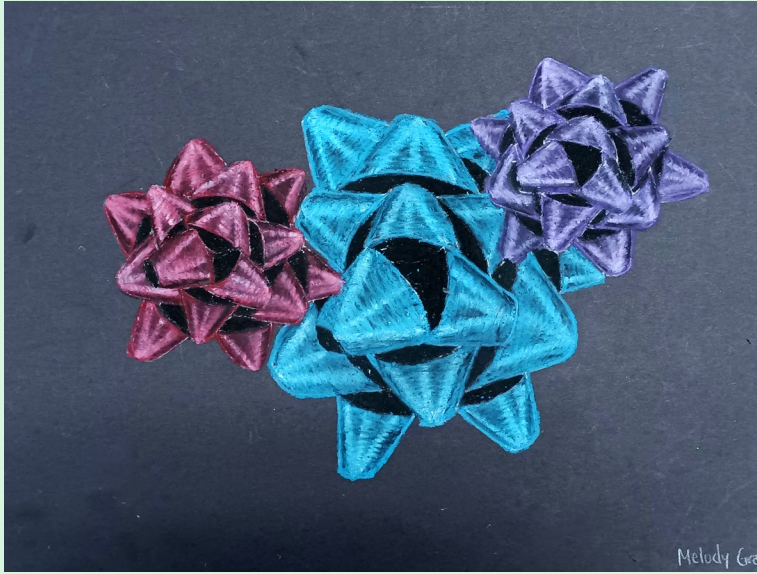

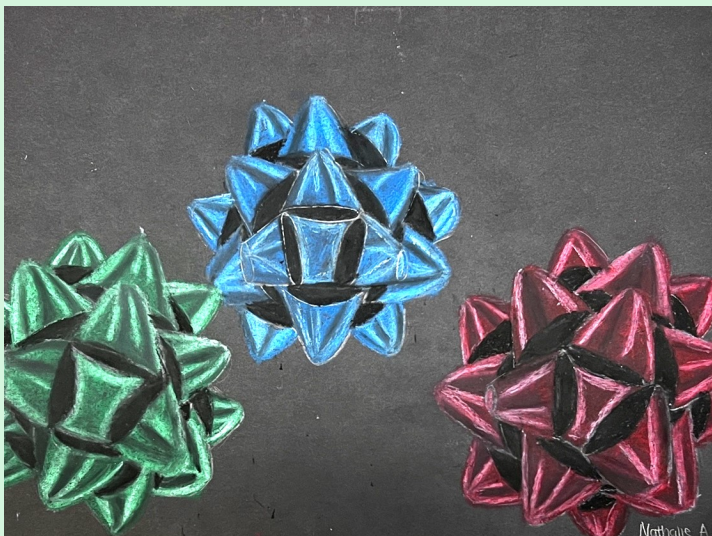




# VISUAL ART
