





Students meeting state grade-level expectations.




#### **MATHEMATICS**

#### **School Goals**

RGS School goals aim to cultivate highly engaged, selfdetermined students who thrive academically and socially. Themes include an emphasis on student well-being, collaboration, and respect and civic-mindedness. Restorative Justice practices are implemented. The school community holds high expectations for academic integrity, a passion for excellence and an emphasis on persistence and resilience. Students will make measured academic progress by frequent review of and response to data.

#### State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% ontime, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

#### Safe & Welcoming Environment

We continue to use a multiagency threat assessment team, lock down and lock out drills. safety tip lines, staff training, and our community resource officer. 



## BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

RGS is a PBIS school. We teach and positively reinforce expected student behaviors. Student supports include in classroom brain break stations, a Sensory Zone, teaching Zones of Regulation and use of Social Thinking curriculum. Middle School instruction emphasizes responsible use of technology and discussions on responsible use of social media. We utilize restorative practices to help students repair relationships and restore community.

## EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

RGS Extracurricular activities are provided both through the RGS PTC and Riverdale School District. RGS PTC Led Events include Oregon Battle of the Books, Community School, Extended Care, and Drama and Art Literacy (during school day).
