NATIONAL ASSESSMENT OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRESS (NAEP) TESTING

Hamden Middle School will participate in the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) on February 12, 2024. NAEP is the largest nationally representative and continuing assessment of what students know and can do in various subjects. It is different from our state and local assessments because it is a common measure of achievement across the country. The assessment is administered by the National Center for Education Statistics, within the U.S Department of Education.

The results are released as The Nation's Report Card, which provides information about student achievement to educators, parents, policymakers and the public. If your child has been chosen to take part in this assessment you will be receiving an email this week.

The assessment takes approximately 2 hours for most students, which includes transition time, directions and completion of survey questions. The information is used for statistical purposes only and your child's grades will not be affected.
