What should students expect while serving on their St. X Service & Immersion Trip?

- Volunteer activities could include construction, farm work, working with kids
- Learn more about issues and challenges families face in urban cities and Appalachia
- Build relationships with other students, chaperones and local community members
- Live simply and be away from the constant connection of cell phones and social media
- Discover new talents, skills and ways of thinking while experiencing a new environment



Cincinnati: Students will explore and gain a deeper understanding of their own city while working with kids, repairing homes and serving the homeless.

Cumberland Valley, KY: The service activities will focus mainly on housing repair and construction and students will learn more about the challenges of rural poverty.

Louisville, KY: While completing construction projects, students will explore the social issues of this culturally and historically rich city.

Toppa Joppa Mountain, TN: While helping with housing repairs, students will discover the challenges immigrants face in rural America.

Toppa Joppa Mountain Children's Camp: Students will help organize and run a summer day camp for kids who live in a local, underserved community.

Wheeling, WV: After working to provide agricultural produce for the underserved, students will explore the state and better understand life in coal country.
