STEM DIPLOMA

This diploma requires:

- 2 additional Science
- 1 additional Math
- 2 years of a Foreign Language
- 3.8 weighted GPA
- 8 Math or Science classes at an Honors or AP level
- ▶ 25 minimum credits





ACADEMIC YEAR

WPA provides year long courses. Students may take up to seven classes each day.

ACCREDITATION

WPA receives accreditation through Cognia.

COURSE DESIGNATION

Higher level courses are designated "honors" in title and are weighted at 4.5. Dual Enrollment courses contain the college course code in title and Advanced Placement courses are designated "AP". Dual Enrollment and AP courses are weighted at 5.0.

NUMERICAL GRADE SCALE

Letter grades are awarded grade points based on a 10 point scale. GPAs are calculated on a 4.0 scale. Both weighted & un-weighted GPAs are listed on the transcript.



- ► PSAT/NMSQT


All Juniors are provided the ACT Test as part of state accountability testing. The ACT average composite score for the class of 2024 was 19.7.
