### **Student Attendance**

We continue to track daily student attendance averages. Our goal is **95%**. These are our trends for the last five months.



August 96% September 93% October 90% November 91% December 89%

Some students' absences are quickly accumulating. According to the the Illinois State Board of Education, a student is "Chronically Absent" if they missed 10% or more of the school year regardless of excuse.

<u>Levels of Absences</u>: **Satisfactory**: Less than 9 absences a year **Warning Signs:** 10 to 17 days **Chronic Absence**: 18 or more days

The Attendance Commission Annual Report. March 15, 2016, reports that "The incremental effect of daily school attendance facilitates the transition of a student from school to career as a functioning and productive member of society."

Do you know how many absences and tardies your children have accumulated so far? *After winter break, families of students with chronic or near chronic numbers of absences will be contacted by the school.*
