

MCC-Maple Woods Dual Credit Placement Requirements

For the Spring 2024 semester you will have the opportunity to enroll in the college credit portion of your PHHS high school dual credit class(s) through MCC-Maple Woods. If you are interested in receiving college credit for your dual credit class(es), you must meet placement qualifications. You can do this with a qualifying cumulative, unweighted GPA and/or ACT/Accuplacer scores.

*English and Reading placement can be dependent upon each other.

*The Math Accuplacer is a two-part test. Students must score high enough on the QAS test to take the AAF test, which will determine eligibility for enrollment.

- An MCC ID number is required to **test or enroll**. If you already have an MCC ID number, you don't need reapply.

*Note: If you do not submit this form, you will NOT be enrolled.

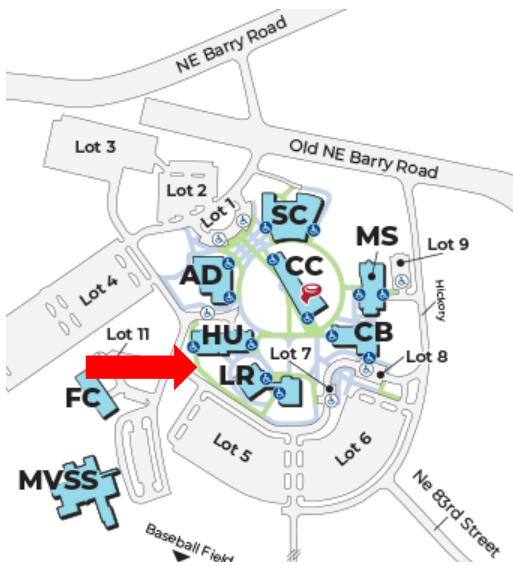
