District Clerk Anthony Sonnacchio declared the polls open at 12:00 noon.

District Clerk Anthony Sonnacchio declared the polls closed at 9:00 p.m.

The Chief Inspector of Election and District Clerk verified the voting results as follows:

PROPOSITION #1 – BUDGET ADOPTION

"Shall the Board of Education of the Marcellus Central School District be authorized to expend the sums set forth in the total amount of \$40,202,463 for the 2023-2024 school year and to levy the necessary tax therefore?"

PROPOSITION#2 – PURCHASE OF BUSES

"Shall the Board of Education ("Board") of the Marcellus Central School District ("District") be authorized to purchase two (2) 66-passenger school buses at a maximum estimated cost of \$153,100 each, one (1) 35-passenger school bus with wheelchair lift at a maximum estimated cost of \$142,600, and one (1) minivan to be used for student transportation at a maximum estimated cost of \$35,000, for a combined maximum estimated expenditure of \$483,800, and to obtain the necessary funds by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the District, to be collected in annual installments in the years and in the amounts as the Board shall determine in accordance with Section 416 of the Education Law, and, in anticipation of such tax, to issue up to \$483,800 of obligations of the District?"

PROPOSITION#3 – CAPITAL RESERVE EXPENDITURE AND UNASSIGNED FUND BALANCE TRANSFER

"Shall the Board of Education of the Marcellus Central School District (the "District") be authorized to (a) withdraw and expend \$3,300,000 from the School District's existing Capital Reserve Fund to pay a portion of the costs of a previously authorized District project, including the construction of agricultural facilities and the acquisition of original furnishings, equipment, machinery and apparatus required for which such facilities and improvements are to be used; and (b) transfer up to \$3,300,000 in unassigned fund balance from the General Fund to the District's existing Capital Reserve Fund?"

"Shall the annual appropriation for the Marcellus Free Library be increased from its current level of \$544,547 per year to \$563,600 per year (an increase of \$19,053), to be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property within the Marcellus Central School District, in accordance with Section 259 of the Education Law?"
