<p>* Assumptions made in projecting a contingency budget for the 2023-24 school year, should the proposed budget be defeated pursuant to Section 2023 of the Education Law, would result in reductions in equipment purchases of \$44,650 and non-represented salaries of \$34,599. The contingency budget could be further reduced, depending on the Board of Education's discretionary use of district reserves to mitigate a 0% increase in the 2023-24 tax levy. Without the use of additional reserves, the contingency budget for the 2023-24 school year would be further reduced by \$445,283 to \$39,677,931.</p>
