PROPOSITION #1 – BUDGET ADOPTION

“Shall the Board of Education of the Marcellus Central School District be authorized to expend the sums set forth in the total amount of \$38,970,001 for the 2022-2023 school year and to levy the necessary tax therefore?”

PROPOSITION#2 – PURCHASE OF BUSES

“Shall the Board of Education (“Board”) of the Marcellus Central School District (“District”) be authorized to purchase two (2) 66-passenger school buses at a maximum estimated cost of \$126,397 each and one (1) 30-passenger school bus with wheelchair lift at a maximum estimated cost of \$135,871, for a combined maximum estimated expenditure of \$388,665, and to obtain the necessary funds by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the District, to be collected in annual installments in the years and in the amounts as the Board shall determine in accordance with Section 416 of the Education Law, and, in anticipation of such tax, to issue up to \$388,665 of obligations of the District?”


