To achieve a level 3 in library, students adhere to the following guidelines:

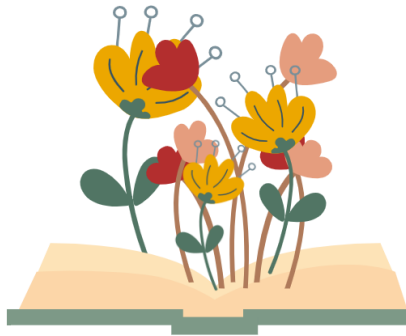
BE KIND AND RESPECTFUL

- Leave Things as You Found Them

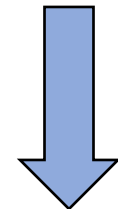


BE YOUR BEST

- Accept Challenges



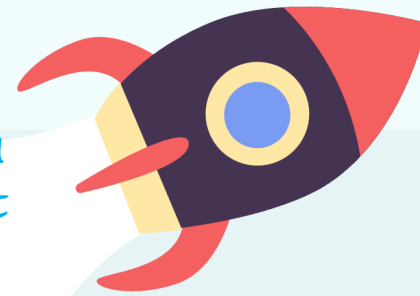
