Cost

- **3 half-days per week**

- **5 half-days per week**
Monday-Friday
\$350/month
- **5 half-days per week**
Monday-Friday
\$250/month (Pomona Elementary)

Times

- 4 hours/day
- Hours vary based on school locations.

Parent Observation

Parents/guardians are invited to participate in a monthly play-based observation, which includes a 30-40 minute observation of your child's play, social and language skills, and classroom readiness.

The session includes a circle time, small group activity and free play.

Program Overview

Students learn side-by-side with their same-aged peers in structured, caring preschool classrooms.

The programs prepare young learners for success in kindergarten, as they participate in small and large group classroom settings, and cooperative play activities.

- Focus is on language and early literacy skills, including phonological awareness and alphabet knowledge; and
- Social and emotional independence, fostered through direct teaching and cooperative play.
