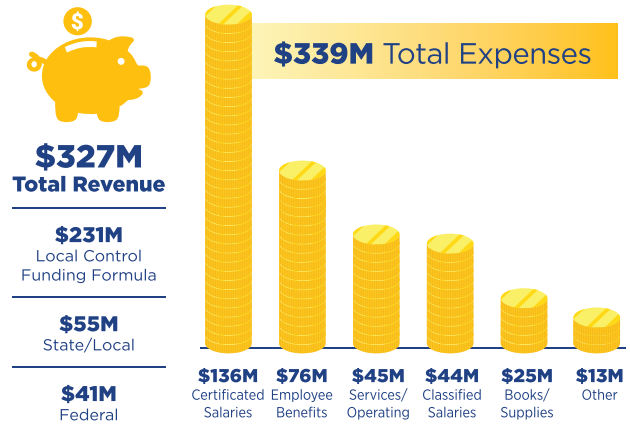

2023/2024

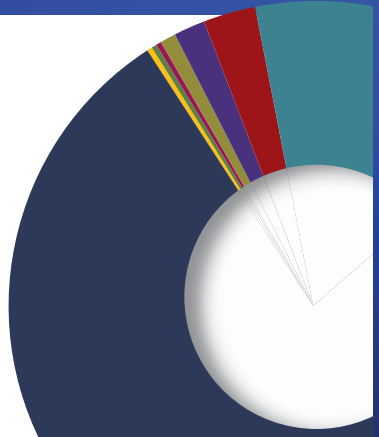
