New Class offerings:

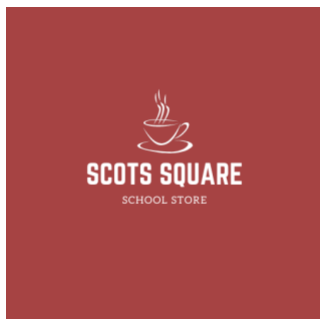
