Candidates Erica and Hue smile with excitement as they are crowned by the Hawkmascot, shown below.














Master of Ceremonies


















5 Fun Filled Days

After college I want to work in a clinic, counseling teen girls and guys about life experiences.








Time For Underclassmen







Blood Drive


