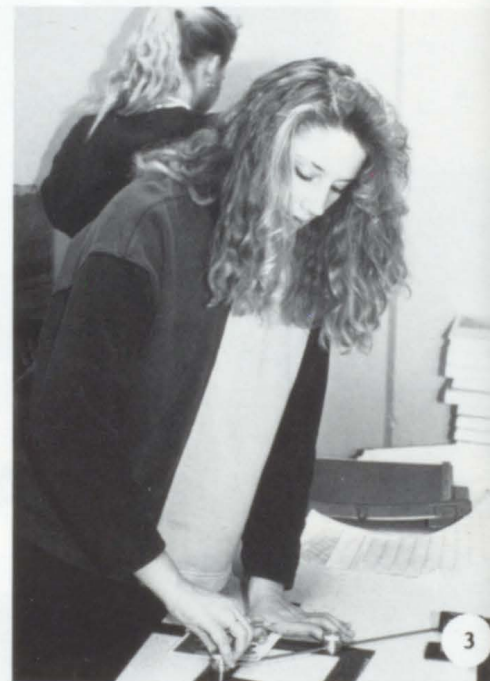

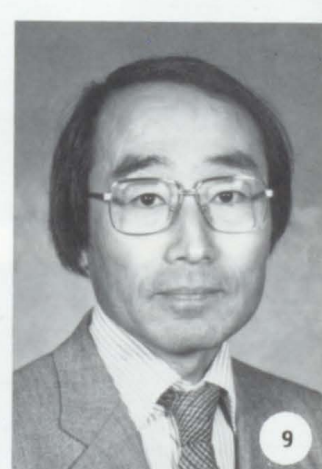

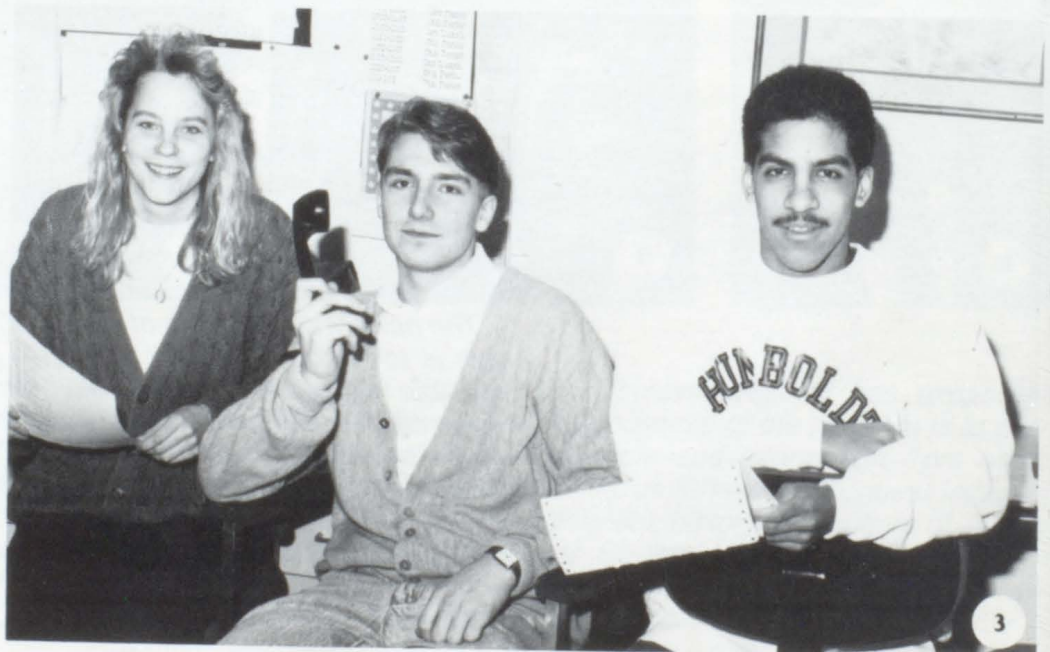

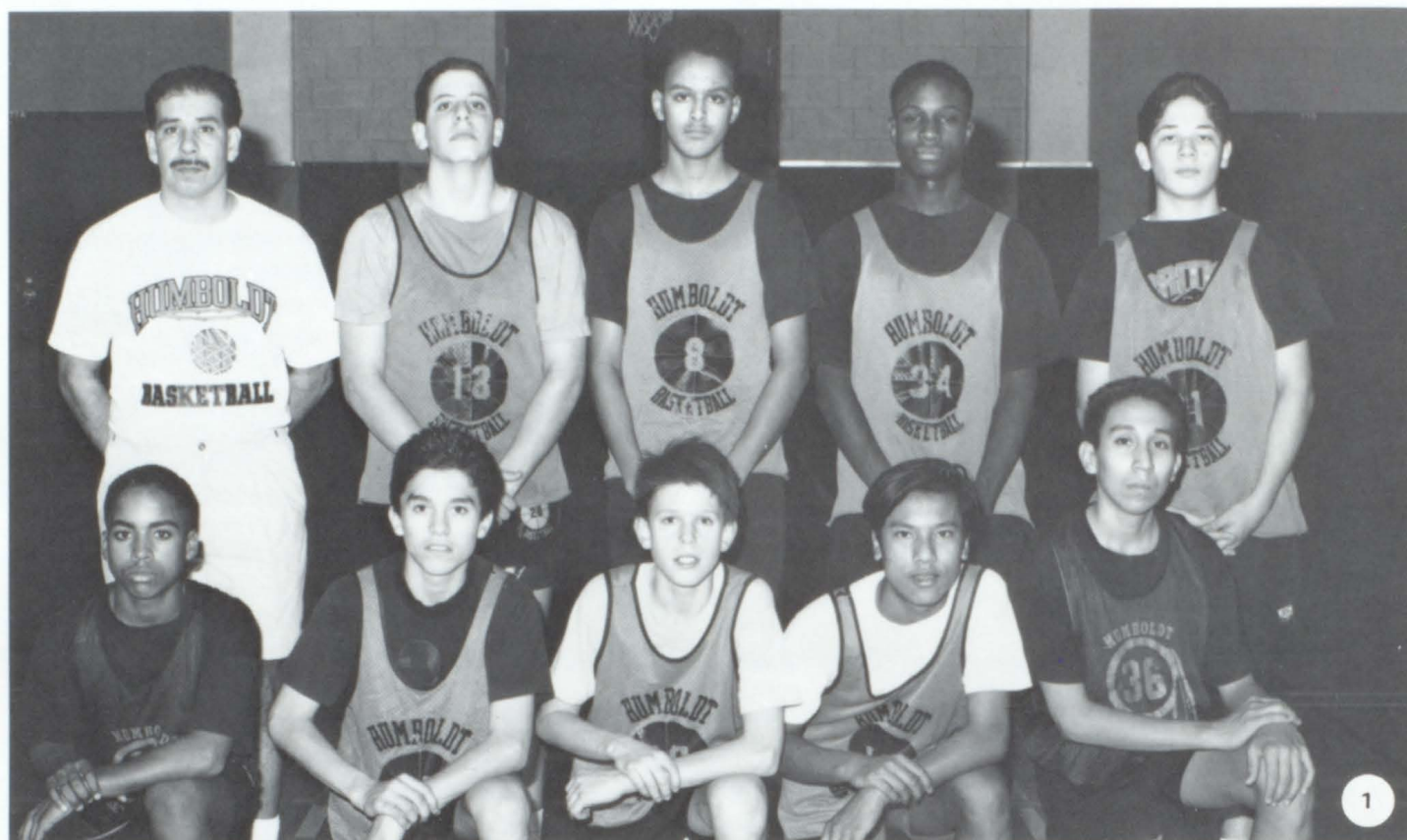

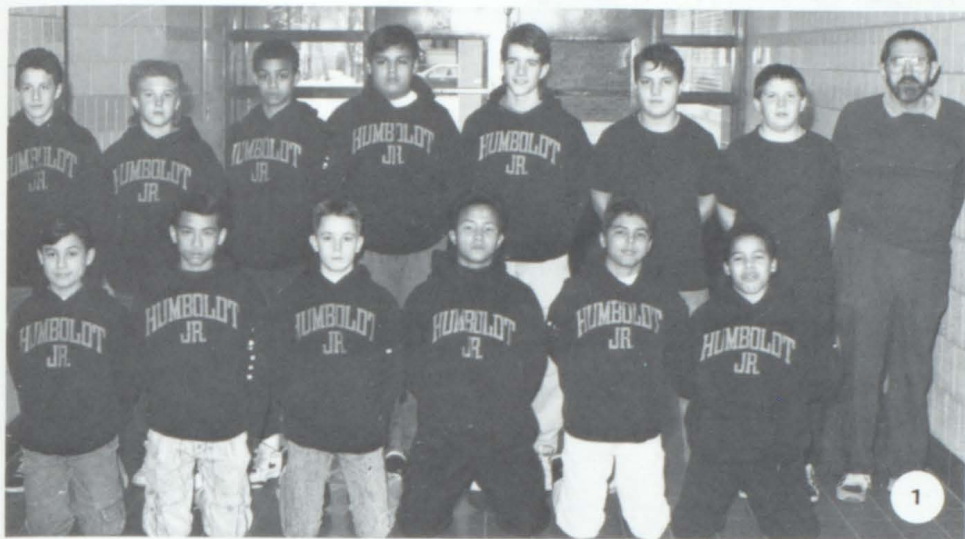

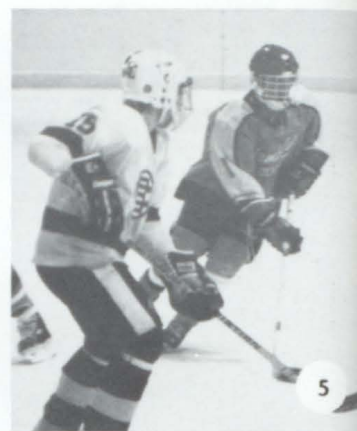

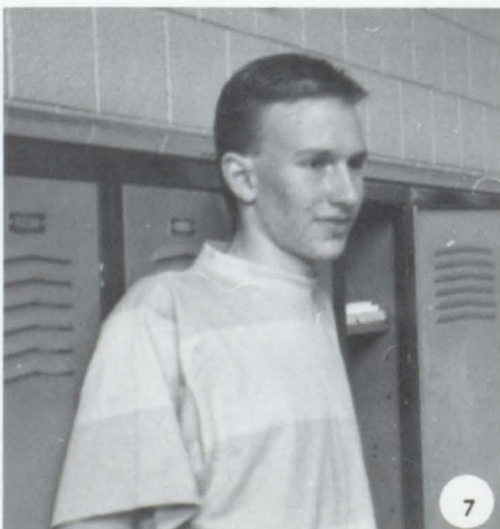

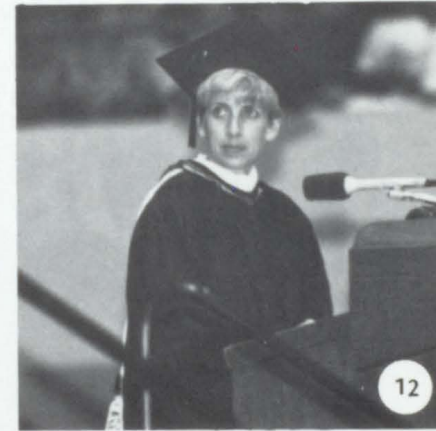


# The Class Of 1991, Takes

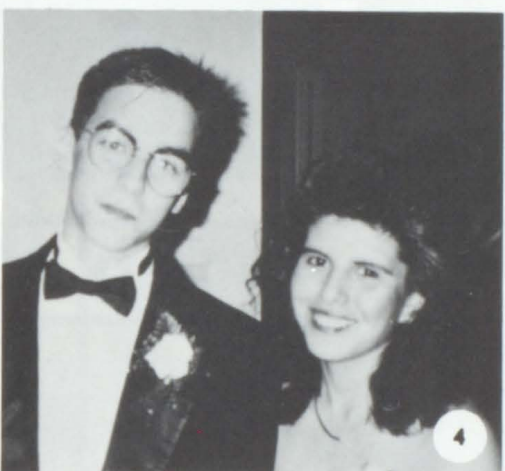

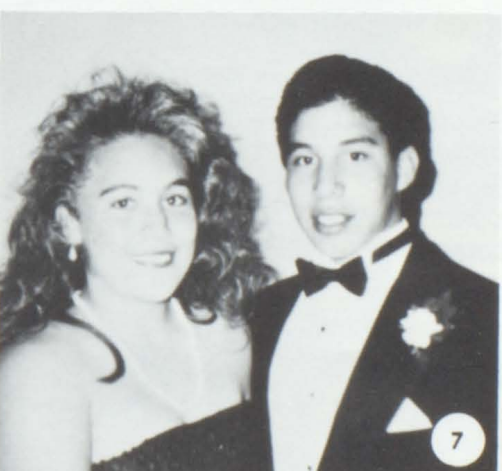

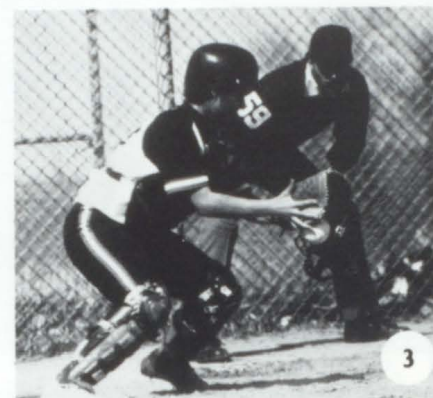
## \*Indians Strive For Wins

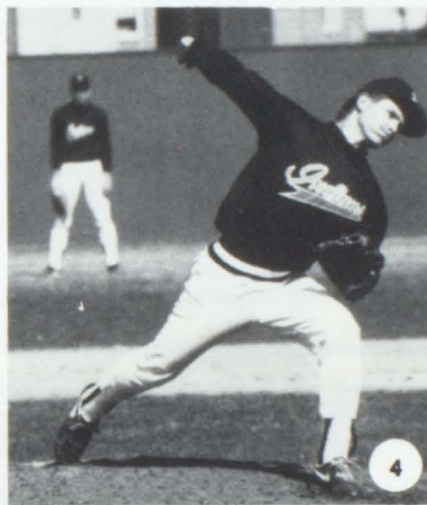

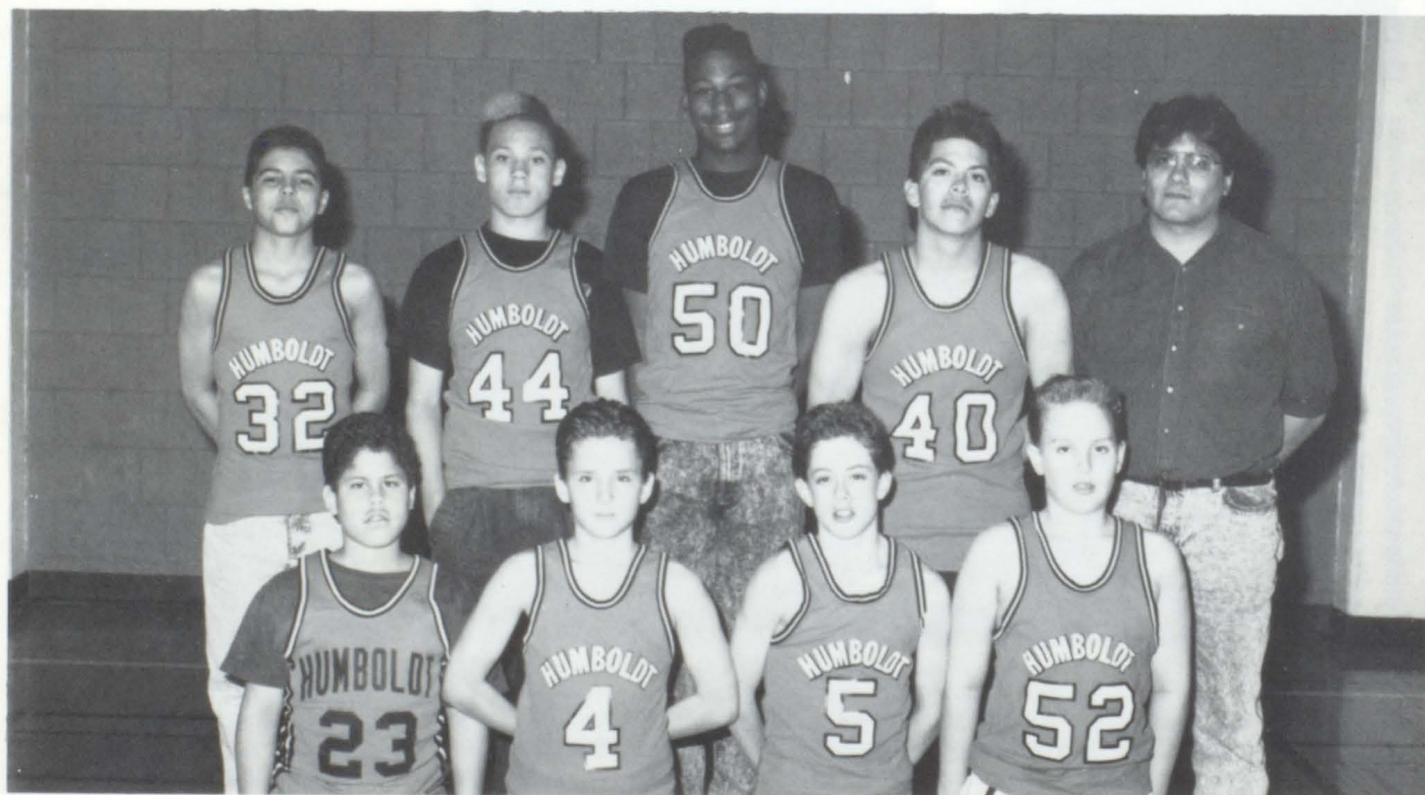

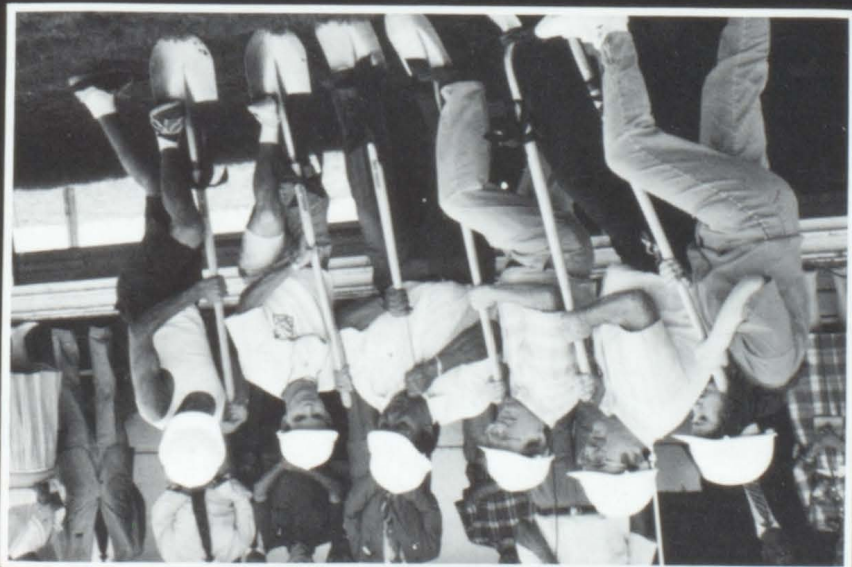
